Scripture: James 1:19-22

LISTEN AND DO GOOD

- 1. Have you ever had a pastor (or heard of a pastor) that preached one thing but did another? Had a fall from grace? How did it make you feel?
- 2. Have you ever done something you knew was wrong, but did it anyway? How did it make you feel? And was it different than how you felt about the pastor who did the same? Why or why not?
- 3. When you are humbled, does it make you feel like rejoicing? Explore why or why not?
- 4. Galatians 5:22-23 tells us that the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. If you compared yourself now to who you were 5 years ago, what fruit has grown in your life? If you compared yourself now to who you hope to be in 5 years ago, what fruit do you want to see growing in your life?
- 5. Do you think you pray for your pastor enough? What small and practical step could you implement to intercede for them more?
