THE SOUL SEEKING GOD

- 1. If we have the desire to seek God, we will find Him offering us love, and not judgement. How do you feel/think about God's judgement? Explore?
- 2. *'We are sought before we seek.'* Bernard argues that grace and the Lord's will precedes any human desire toward God. Do you agree? Why or why not? Discuss.
- 3. *'The soul is lethargic."* Have you ever experienced wanting/willing to do something, but not been able to follow through? Explore and discuss.
- 4. We often seek God in times of desperation, but do you desperately seek God in times of abundance? Why or why not?
- 5. If you think of your best trait, do you think of it as yours, and that you cultivated it? Or do you think of it as a gift from God?
