DENYING SELF

1. In what ways does Augustine's interpretation of self-denial challenge or deepen your understanding of discipleship in the Christian faith?
2. Augustine emphasizes that denying oneself is essential to following Christ. What are some modern examples of 'self-denial' in daily life that you think align with this teaching?
3. How does Augustine's message address the tension between our desires and our faith commitments? What steps can we take to align our actions with a faith-driven life?
4. Augustine discusses the idea of following Christ through sacrifice. What are some sacrifices or commitments that may be difficult but necessary for deepening one's faith?
5. How might Augustine's message on self-denial encourage a stronger community within the Church? What role does individual sacrifice play in building collective faith?
